

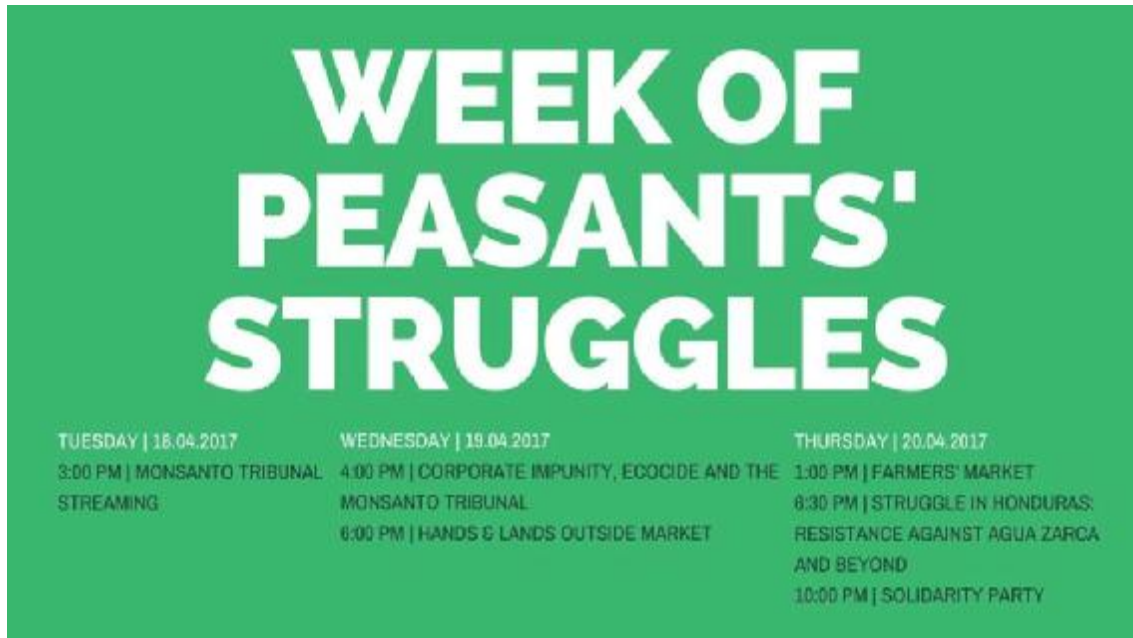
Week of Peasants' Struggles at ISS

April 17th is called upon as a day for mobilizations around the world for the rights of peasants, for food sovereignty and against the repression of social movements. On this day in 1996, 19 peasants were killed by the police in the north of Brazil while they were demanding land reform. Since then, rural social movements around the world, many of them organized in La Via Campesina, have mobilized around this date as an International Day of Peasant Struggles.
